US Congresswoman Brenda Lawrence's Chief Aides: Jeremy Kaplan & Varun Krovi

In advance of Mahindra Automotive North America's formal public unveiling on November 20th, the company hosted recent tours for local and national officials of note. October 13th saw visits by Varun Krovi and Jeremy Kaplan—representatives from the Office of US Congresswoman Brenda Lawrence (MI-14). In the House of Representatives, Congresswoman Lawrence serves as a Senior Whip, Vice Chair of the Congressional Caucus for Women's Issues and Secretary of the Congressional Black Caucus. She serves on the Transportation and Infrastructure Committee and on the Subcommittee on Aviation, Subcommittee on Highway and Transit, Subcommittee on Water, Resources and Environment. She is also a member on the House Oversight & Government Reform Committee where she serves on the subcommittee on Government Operation.
